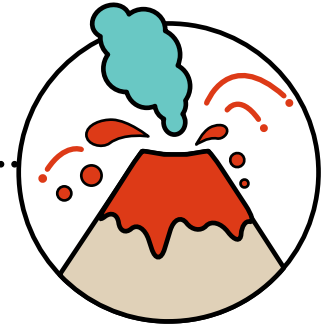


How Trauma Can Affect Your Window Of Tolerance

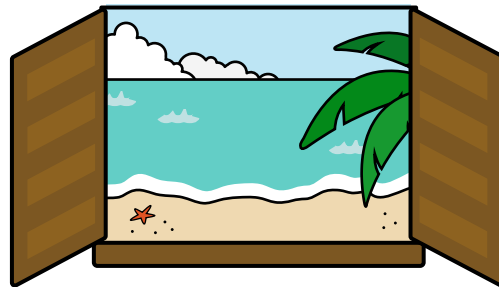
HYPERAROUSAL

It's not something you choose – these reactions just take over.

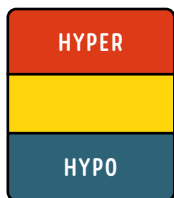


WINDOW OF TOLERANCE

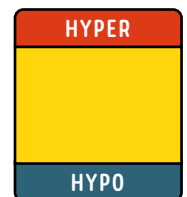
